Application received for a quarry at Chiltern

Indigo Shire Council has received an application from Holcim (Australia) Pty Ltd for a new quarry at Skeleton Hill, Chiltern.

The licence for the present quarry inside the Chiltern-Mt Pilot National Park expires this month and Holcim has this week applied to Indigo Shire to establish a new quarry outside the park boundary between Black Dog Creek Road and Forrest Lane.

Details of the application are now on the Indigo Shire Website www.indigoshire.vic.gov.au and copies of the application are available for viewing at Customer Service Centres in Chiltern and Yackandandah. CD copies of the application are also available for loan.

A Council officer and representative of the applicant will be available on Monday 23 November from 4pm to 7pm and Tuesday 24 November from 10am to 1pm in the Chiltern Community Centre at 52 Main Street, Chiltern, to explain the application and decision-making process and to answer questions.
